

## The Hawai'i Nature Center announces our newest program: "From Mauka to Makai: Understanding Climate Change Impacts in the Ahupua`a"

Welcome middle school teachers! This unique place-based science program offers hands-on, STEM-related field activities that focus on investigating climate change impacts from ridge to reef. We are offering TWO field trips that are designed to complement each other, one in the Mauka and one in the Makai region. There is a discount for booking BOTH field trips. Also, scholarships are available for Title 1 schools, as well as non-Title 1 schools who are in need of funding support.

### The Mauka Field Trip - *Makiki Valley:*

Students will learn the basic science of climate change and how humans are the main contributors of today's global warming. The day is packed with three hands-on activities out in the field that relate to sustainability and doing our part in helping to slow down the worst effects of climate change.

- Stream Investigations/Water Quality
- Adventures in Biomimicry
- Climate and Forest Explorations

### The Makai Field Trip

*Sandy Beach Park or other beach near you!:*

Students will learn about climate impacts on the shoreline, coastal wildlife, tide pools and the coral reefs. The three hands-on rotations include:

- Tide Pool Investigations
- Coastal Hike/ Service Learning
- Garbology/ Marine Debris
