GARDENING & LANDSCAPING

Maintain planted areas around the Hawai'i Nature Center. Includes planting, propagation, weeding, watering, and composting.

Time commitment: At least twice a month. Botanical work occurs regularly on Tuesdays and Fridays.

FACILITIES MAINTENANCE

Help maintain and beautify our facilities. Includes simple construction and repair projects, painting, and cleaning.

Time commitment: Varies as you are available.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Assist HNC staff with the facilitation of educational crafts and games for children, inform the public of our mission, and connect with our local community!

Time commitment: Varies depending on event.

MONTHLY VOLUNTEER DAY

Using our power in numbers, we tackle the larger projects on campus. Includes landscaping projects, trail repair, maintenance of outdoor program spaces and invasive species removal.

Time commitment: Occurs first Saturday of the month, 9AM- 12PM

SERVICE LEARNING PROJECTS

Volunteer groups join us for a day of both education and action. We will pair your project with an educational hike or interactive lesson. Project focus varies depending on programmatic needs at that time.
